

## Vietnam

All students on this program will be required to have a student visa for entry into Viet Nam. **SIT will send you visa instructions via email in June/July for Fall programs and December/early January for Spring programs.**

In order to start the approval process, we will submit the completed form below to our visa sponsor. This form must be submitted with your Confirmation Materials.

### COMMON MISTAKES OF PAST APPLICANTS

- **Pencil:** All official documents should always be filled out with blue or black ink, ballpoint pens. Please do not use a gel pen. Typed answers are preferred.
- **Streaking printer:** Please print on a high quality printer using black ink.
- **Bad penmanship:** Remember that being granted a visa is a privilege; do what you can to make it easier for the Immigration staff reviewing your application. Use **CAPITAL** letters for this application.
- **Signature and Date:** Please don't forget to sign and date this application.
- **Dating convention:** should be day/month/year or day Month year: 12 June 2008.
- **Not following instructions:** if you have questions, contact your Admissions Counselor.

## VIETNAM PRE VISA INSTRUCTIONS

7. If your passport is being renewed or you are applying for a passport for the first time, please leave this section blank to be completed by your Admissions Counselor once you received the new passport.

8. Date of issuance: date, month, year (from passport)
9. Date of expiration: date, month, year (from passport)
10. Date of Entry and Exit: 7 days before the program starts and 7 days after the program ends.
11. Numbers of entry: MULTIPLE (already completed for you)
12. Place to Get Visa: USA (if you have a non-US passport, contact your Admissions Counselor)
13. Consular jurisdiction: Washington DC (if you have a non-US passport, contact your Admissions Counselor)
