June 15 for all other summer programs

# What Happens Next ...

Once we have received all of your application materials, including approval of participation, our Admissions Committee will review your application. You may be contacted to discuss your application or be requested to provide additional information. Offers of admissions are generally made within one to two weeks. You will then have two weeks to reserve your space in the course by submitting your deposit and any other required confirmation materials. A list of these items will be provided with your offer of admission.

### Scholarships and Financial Aid

SIT Scholarships are not available for short-term programs, however, those who complete any SIT short-term program are eligible for SIT Alumni Scholarships on an international spring, summer, or fall program.
